The Committee meeting began at 11:25am. Joanne took roll, gave out calendars, and asked Committee members to fill out the required Confidentiality Agreement.

Content to Members

Joanne explained to the Committee that all information needs to be approved by her before being sent to the general membership.

Facebook Page

Abby Reid joined the meeting to discuss the creation of a SC Facebook page. She explained how it could be beneficial to SC USA Gymnastics professional members to send updates, reminders, post schedules, etc. The Committee thanked Abby for her presentation, and she left the meeting. The Committee then discusses the idea of having a SC Facebook page. All submissions by administrators would still need to be approved by the Chairman. A limited number of administrators will be determined, yet should include the Chairman, the level representatives, and the State Judging Director. NCAA Acro & Tumbling College Team

Joanne provided information regarding the Converse College NCAA Acro & Tumbling Team and announced that the Head Coach, Keegan Johnson would be speaking at the SC USA Gymnastics Open Meeting. Additionally, we would have acro gymnasts from Spartanburg Gymnastics performing.

State Meet T-shirt Design

Joanne reminded us that the Committee was responsible for the design of the State Meet t-shirt. The Committee has

decided to host a contest for the athletes attending a training camp to submit a t-shirt design. The t-shirt design must include the SC USA Gymnastics logo on the front. Anna will send information to the participants prior to each training camp, allowing submissions to be brought to camp or the participants could send their submission to Anna by December 15th. The Committee will vote on the final design, and \$100 will be awarded to the winner of the contest.

State Meet Volunteer Requirement for Judges

Joanne reviewed the State Meet Volunteer Requirement for Judges to be eligible to judge the SC USA Gymnastics State Meets. She asked the SJD to send a reminder to the judges. Judges who are unable to meet the volunteer requirement should petition to the Committee as soon as possible.

The Committee then reviewed the agenda for the Open Meeting and made last minute preparations.

Our next Committee meeting will be held at the SC NAWGJ Judges Cup in Columbia, date and time to be determined.
